# Glossary

## **Annual**

A plant that completes its life cycle within one year.

## **Biennial**

A plant that completes its life cycle within two years.

## **Ground Cover**

Low-growing plants that spread, stopping weeds from growing. Ground covers help provide protection of the topsoil from erosion and drought.

## **Herbaceous**

Plants with flexible, green stems with few to no woody parts.

## **Medicinal Uses**

The use of plants to treat disease and enhance general health and wellbeing.

## **Native**

Occurred naturally in the Texas Hill Country region, ecosystem, or habitat without human introduction.

## **Nitrogen Fixing**

Helps supply plants with the vital nutrient that they cannot obtain from the air themselves.

## **Ornamental**

Plants that constitute natural living beauty, while enriching the quality of human life.

## **Perennial**

A perennial is a plant that lives more than two years and regrows each spring.

# Pollinator friendly

Pollinator plants maintain a healthy pollinator population, which allows for crops and flowers to continue producing seeds and fruits via insect pollination (as well as a healthy garden and vibrant ecosystem).

### 1. Clay

- Sticky texture when wet
- Does not drain water well
- Shrinks when it dries, swells when wet

### 2. Silt

- Feels smooth & floury when dry
- Can be molded, but doesn't hold together when released
- Rich in nutrients

### 3. Sand

- Can easily fall through fingers, feels gritty
- Drains water too quickly
- Acidic & low in nutrients













### 4. Loam

- mixture of sand, silt and clay
- Good water drainage
- A gardeners best friend

**Note for Gardening:** Your soil will likely be a combination of different types. You should consider mixing organic matter, such as compost, with your soil for the best results.
